6mm SF Communications Centre by Stone Mountain Miniatures

was fortunate enough to be sent a sample casting of the Communications Centre which is a new addition to the 6mm Science Fiction Buildings range produced by Stone Mountain Miniatures (http://www.historicalminiatures.com/index.html). This fits in perfectly in the style of design with the other existing items in the range, and is a very nice addition to a set of buildings which feature a very pleasing hard-SF look.

The Communications Centre is predominantly a resin building, but features metal details for the three satellite dishes ó these also have some lovely small detailing of access hatches and panels. The Communications Centre is a significantly sized construction, measuring 6cm long, 3.5cm wide and just under 5cm high. It consists of what would appear to be a series of offices at one end of the building, an array of satellite dishes in the central portion and a lower building with possibly some sort of a radar sensor array attached to a laboratory. The model features a number of doors and windows, and fits nicely together as a small complex.







It certainly looks the part when viewed with 6mm tanks and power armoured infantry.



This, then, is another excellent design from Stone Mountain miniatures 6 it isnot on their web-site lists yet, but I would guess that when it does get listed itoll retail around the \$7 mark, which is pretty good for terrain in this niche scale. Anyone who has any of the previous offerings in this range will certainly want to add this to their scenery set.
